



Demonstrative ADJECTIVES

A demonstrative adjective is used to point out a specific person, place, or thing. It matches the singular or plural form and past or present tense.

Example: This is my book. (The adjective "this" points out the specific book.)

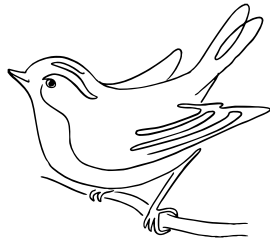
