Like other months that celebrate certain groups, Women's History Month used to only be celebrated for one week. However, by the mid-1990s, people started celebrating Women's History Month in the entire month of March.

Some states even held contests to see who could write the best essay about Women's History Month and this also helped people to learn about the celebration.
