A blobfish is an interesting sea creature. When it is in the water, it looks like a regular fish, but if it is taken out of the water, its body is soft and lumpy. It has soft bones. Blobfish live deep in the ocean.

Jellyfish are also very interesting. Jellyfish do not have a brain, eyes, or a heart. It has no bones. They have long tentacles that can sting whatever they want to eat. They like to eat fish or shrimp. There are many different types of jellyfish and some of them glow in the dark!
