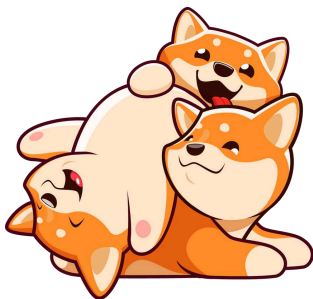
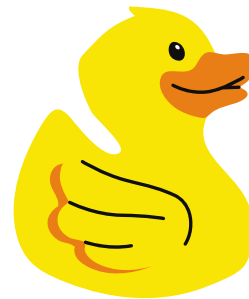
Circle the poems that are odes. Put an "X" through the ones that are not.
